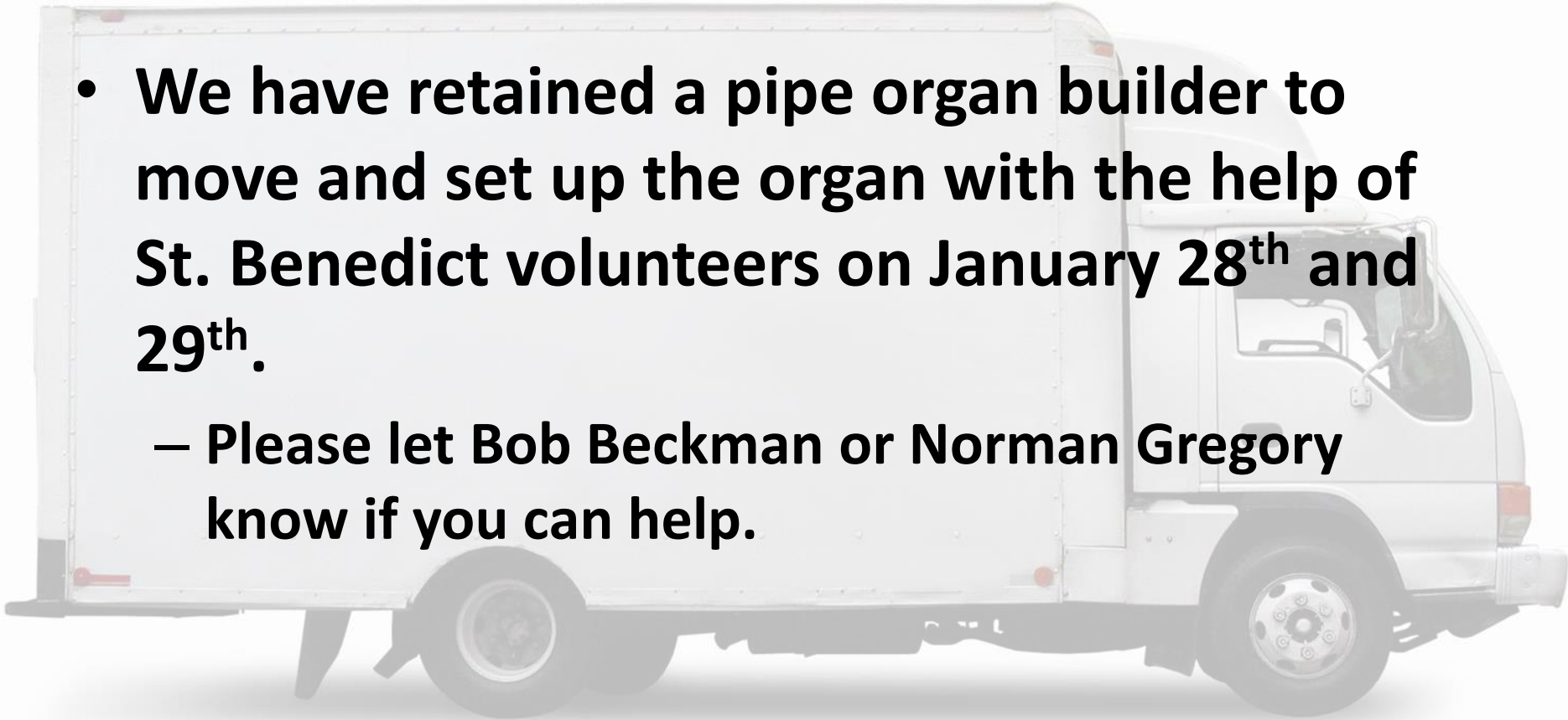


Where will it fit??

How will it get here from Seattle?

- **We have retained a pipe organ builder to move and set up the organ with the help of St. Benedict volunteers on January 28th and 29th.**

How much will it cost to move and set up?

- Now that we've gotten a final estimate on the cost of moving it we've revised our fundraising goal to \$7500 (any extra funds will be used for maintaining the organ in the future).
